## About John Edmiston



John is a bible-teacher and Christian technologist who has been in missions since 1981 and using technology in ministry since 1991 before there was even much of an Internet. In 1994 John came up with the first prayer website on the Internet and the first large bible-teaching website on the Internet.

John is an Australian and has ministered in Australia, Papua New Guinea, the Philippines and throughout South-East Asia. His conference speaking takes him around the world. Home is Carson CA where he lives with his wife Minda and where they have an active role in their local church.

## What We Do And How We Go About Doing It

Cybermissions trains Christian leaders and makes disciples using four main programs which are named after their main websites:

**GlobalChristians.Org** provides discipleship and training materials for the global church, including the Harvestime church-planting training. This website has been ongoing since late 2001 and receives about 500,000 unique visitors per year.

**Cybermissions.Org** provides training in technology for church and mission. This includes the popular Mobile Ministry Training Course and training in Internet Evangelism. This program also includes conference speaking and consultancy with global missions agencies. Cybermissions projects are driven by needs from the field and by requests from field workers.

## How You Can Partner With Cybermissions

Cybermissions does "a lot with a little". We research our projects carefully and use the simplest and most dependable technological solutions that will withstand the rugged environments that we sometimes work in.

We also ask our partners to provide some of the on-the-ground expenses according to their capacity to do so. This also brings "ownership" to the work.

**BiblicalEQ.Com** provides leadership training and coaching for missionaries and other Christian workers. This includes, a book, workbook, DVDs, and personal coaching.

**EternityRadio.Org** This is the newest of our programs and is just getting underway. It will provide a two-year bible college course in audio format. We will provide this training both as an Internet radio station and also via wireless hotspots in remote areas that lack Internet access. Audio training using MP3 files is very useful in areas where reading and writing are less favored or where there can be severe bandwidth restrictions on the downloading of video. Audio also works well on mobile phones which are common in the developing world.

Cybermissions achieves all its goals in partnership with other organizations such as the Harvestime International Network, the Mobile Ministry Forum, the Urban Leadership Foundation and Encarnacao Alliance, and MAF Learning Technologies. We also partner with national churches and mission agencies, particularly those working among Muslims in South-East Asia. All projects are designed to meet real needs as expressed by local leadership.

Cybermissions engages around 1.2 million people per year with our websites and trains in depth over 1000 people through our online courses and mission-field conferences.

John is an intercessor and he believes that prayer is the true power in missions work. Technology is simply a means of multiplying the spread of the gospel and spreading the fragrance of Jesus Christ.
