### Corporation

Cybermissions was first incorporated in the Philippines in 2001 as the Asian Internet Bible Institute, then in the USA (in California, as a religious non-profit) in 2004, as the Asian Internet Bible Institute – International and was later renamed Cybermissions. We received our 501c3 letter in 2006 and have operated with a CEO and a five-member volunteer board, none of whom are related to each other. The board meets approximately quarterly.
