Cybermissions uses computers and the Internet to facilitate the Great Commission via: websites, ebooks, podcasts, online courses, email courses, Internet cafes, AM radio, Internet radio and mobile apps. Between all of these methods we are now engaging with about 1.2 million people per year, and we hope to reach millions more people by the end of 2019.

Cybermissions exists at the intersection of theology, technology and missions. We are mainly focused on providing informal, non-formal and formal training to pastors and committed Christians in the developing world.

In 2019 we have five projects that will work together to provide high quality training to those who are most in need in the Kingdom of God:

1. Firstly we need much better equipment to produce high quality audio and video content.
2. Then we will distribute that content via our websites, and our [Pastorbox](#) wireless hotspot..
3. Intersecting with this will be a shortwave radio program in Africa that will both give direct Bible teaching and inform people about our various websites.
4. This in turn will send people to our online Harvestime Institute where they can do an A.A degree for just \$7 per subject (about \$155 for the entire degree).
5. In the slums of Kampala, Uganda we will also set up an Internet café / learning center so over 300 urban poor pastors can study and get the qualification that will soon be required by the government of Uganda.

We have an offer from Radio Africa, for shortwave radio time, on a 100,000 watt station that broadcasts across Nigeria, Ghana and many English-speaking countries in Africa where 90%+ of people own shortwave capable radios (to listen to the BBC and other international broadcasters) and over 30% listen to shortwave daily!

It would only be \$80 per week, or \$4,160 per year. I simply cannot think of a better way to spend \$4K! Millions will hear the gospel! Will you please consider helping Cybermissions with this amazing project ?

We already have the computers donated for the Internet café in Kampala and just need the air freight to get them there as shipping by sea would require them to go via Kenya which is slow , rough and corrupt.. The shipping and initial setup costs of the Internet café will be approximately \$5000—\$7,000 depending on what sort of a freight discount I can negotiate.

The Harvestime Institute is an exciting partnership between Cybermissions and our friends at the Harvestime International Network. They have developed an amazing curriculum for evangelism, church-planting and pastor training that has been translated into over a dozen languages and which is entirely free to download and use. The 21 subjects take about 2 years to complete and are a good basis for an A.A. degree. Due to the ability to offer automated online testing we will be able to offer an Associate of Arts in Biblical Studies for just \$7 per subject. Or about \$155 for the entire degree including initial enrollment fees!

Cybermissions is the technical and administrative partner and we will need about \$2000 to provide the server for the first year while things get up and running, after which it will be self-funding.

Our [Pastorbox](#) wireless hotspot is a rugged device suitable for distributing content in remote areas where there is no electricity or Internet. The Pastorbox generates a wireless signal, which enables mobile phones, tablets and computers to download our training content from an SD card on the Pastorbox. After two and half years developing this we are now partnering with Megavoice to manufacture them in bulk. We are asking for \$10,000 to get 50 of these devices to the field (\$200 each) fully loaded with content in relevant local languages (from our various content partners).

Finally we actually need some equipment to do all of his! Our office computers are in need of replacement and we require much better audio-visual equipment to keep up with the demand for quality in the 21st century. This would be another \$10,000
